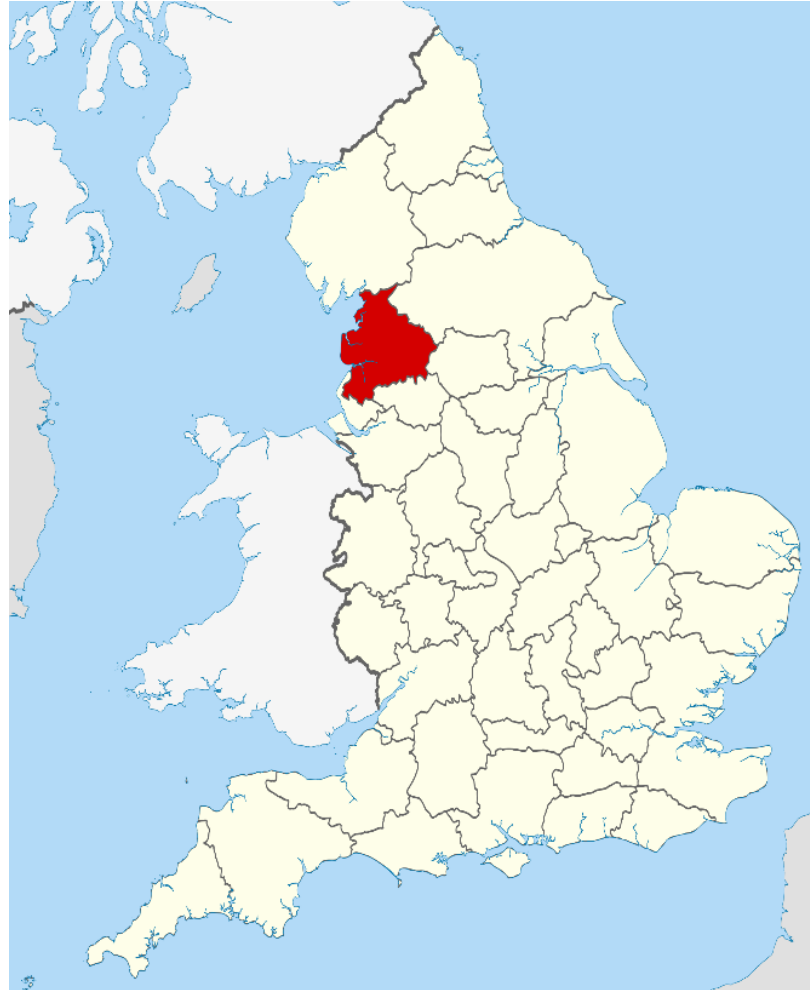

Administration

- 3,075sq kilometres – mixed rural/urban
- 1.45 million resident population
- 12 district councils
- 2 unitary authorities
- 1 county council



Lancashire – Local Government



Water

- 123 km of coastline
- 3 major and many smaller rivers
- Over 55,000 properties at risk of flooding
- 67 flood warning areas
- 38 Rapid Response catchments
- 72.4 km of canals
- 101 registered reservoirs
- Off-shore industry



Transport

- 5 Motorways - 172 km
- 326 km rail track
- Road/rail movements of nuclear and chemical material
- 2 airfields – BAE Systems Warton and Blackpool
- 2 sea ports – Heysham and Glasson Dock

- 22 million visitors per year to Blackpool

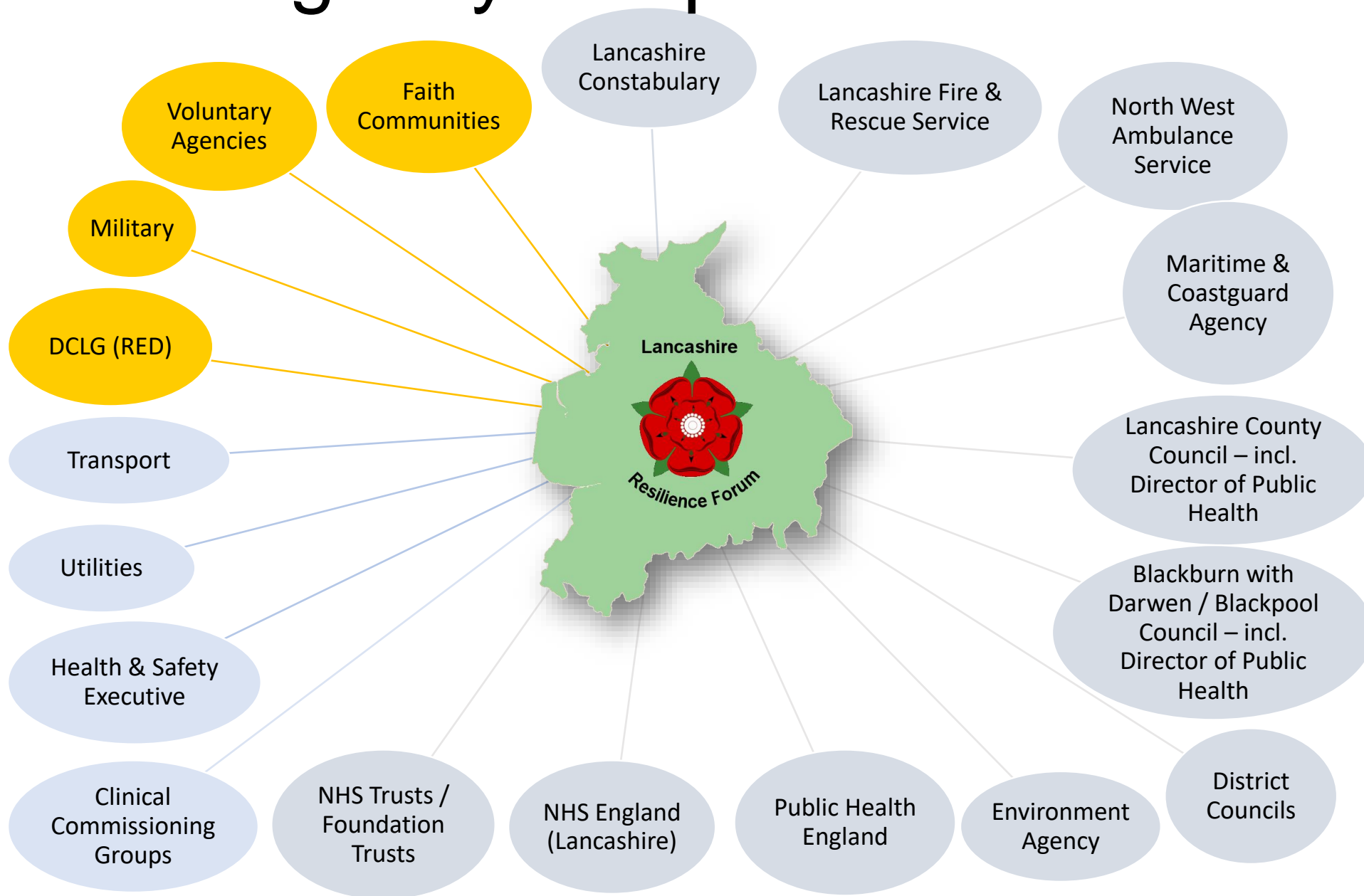
