### → EU Context





- European Electronic Communications Code – article 110
  - □ when imminent or developing major emergencies and disasters
  - ☐ public warnings are transmitted by providers of mobile number-based interpersonal communications services to the end-users concerned.
  - ☐ end-users concerned: those located in the geographic areas potentially being affected

Deadline: 21 June 2022 - Directive 2018/1972





 Transmission through other ways if effectiveness of the public warning system is <u>equivalent</u> in terms of coverage and capacity to reach endusers, including those only temporarily present in the area concerned.
