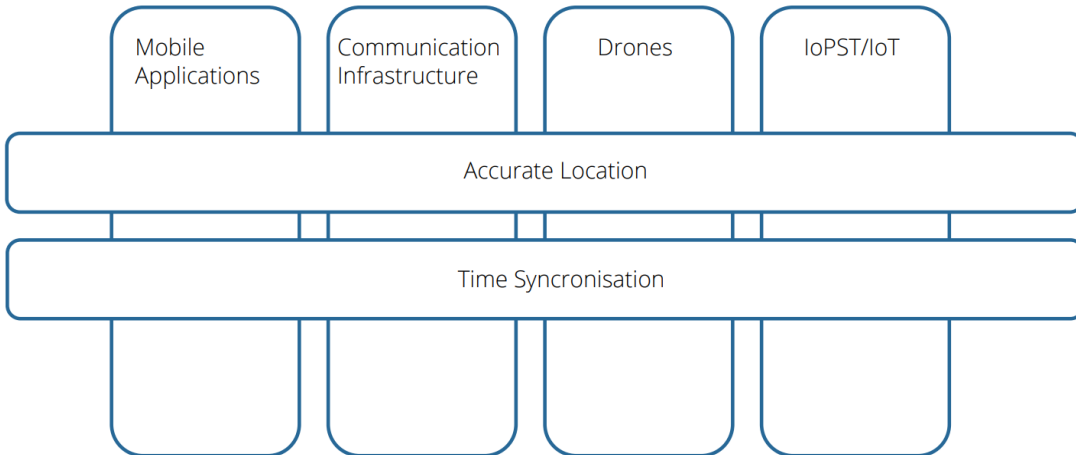

A smaller scale than BroadWay but complementary

Procurement of Innovative solutions to develop Deployed EGNSS Applications, Synchronisation and Monitoring of Critical Mobile Broadband Communication Infrastructure and Information Assets for PPDR

Important year: Phase 3 – Last Phase

✓ Pilots organised for the buyers in March for the technical evaluation and in June & July for the practitioners in May 2022

More than 50 participants are expected for each pilot:

- ❖ Forest Fire in Ljubljana (Slovenia) – June 2022 - Airbus
- ❖ Drug smuggling in Kerkrade (NL) – June-July 2022 (Airbus – Frequentis)
- ❖ Ferry Fire in Malaga (Spain) – July 2022 - Frequentis

Next steps: BroadNet discussions are now kicked off (governance and sustainability of BroadWay from the Buyers/public authorities perspective)

Internal Security Fund project – 10 of May 2022 with an interested group of countries (Core Group – 12 MS present) to define the tasks and governance of BroadNet.



BroadNet

A very first collaboration was initiated with 3 countries (France-Belgium-NL, with the support of UK)

A proposal for a study under the programme Connecting Europe Facility 5G Corridors was submitted in April to prepare for 5G transport corridor deployment across the rail network (Eurotunnel and Eurostar).

This 5G transport corridor will bring the following benefits:

- Seamless continuity of services for Mission Critical, Business Critical and Consumer travellers.
- New Mission Critical services for Police and Emergency Services to allow for Operational mobility of responders.
- New possibilities for Future Rail Communication Services (FRMCS)

- Webinar on Training for SAR operations 24 March 2022 (+100 participants, multidisciplinary approach (Sea/mountain/CBRN/ Galileo SAR/K9)
- Webinar on citizen & community engagement for SAR operations (end of 2022)
